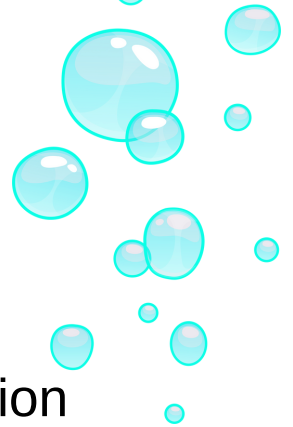
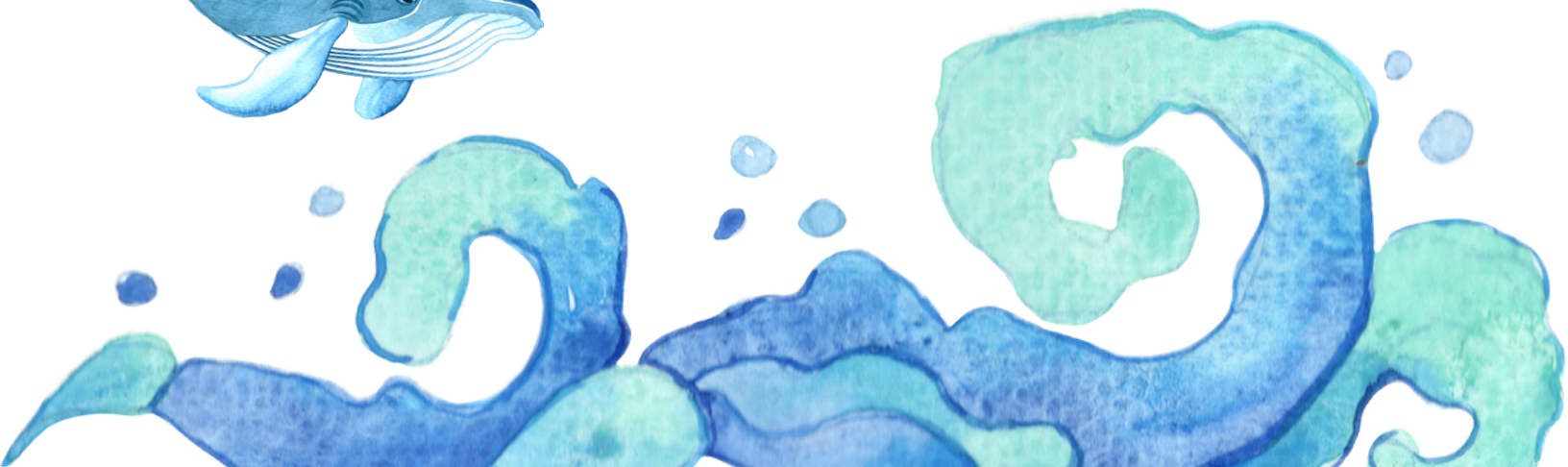
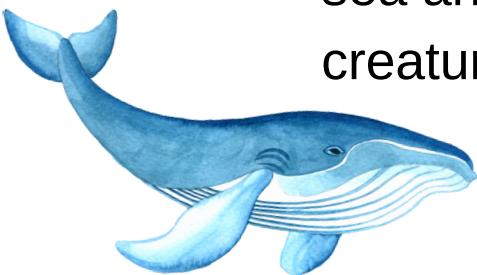

GLOBAL CUISINES

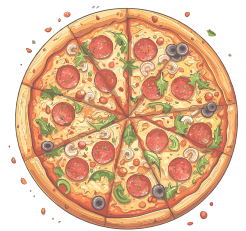
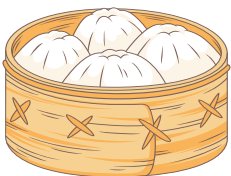


- Share stories and legends related to the origin of specific dishes, connecting food to cultural narratives
